COLUMBARIUM NICHE'S AND NICHE COVERS

ESTABLISHING THE PROCESS FOR ACQUIRING A COLUMBARIUM NICHE AND NICHE COVER

1. Requests for a Columbarium Niche on the Veterans Section of the Chief Tecopa Cemetery will be handled by the Town of Pahrump, at the Town Office.
2. The niche location assignments will start on the top left hand corner of the columbarium and proceed horizontally across the columbarium, then drop to the next row and again proceed horizontally left to right, repeating this process until all available columbarium niches are assigned.
3. Upon receipt of a deposit, application and completion of a Niche Agreement, the niche requestors are assigned the next available niche using the above procedure. A small plaque reading "RESERVED" will be installed at the Town of Pahrump's expense, on each assigned niche.
4. Effective June 1, 2012, the current cost for a columbarium niche at the Veterans Section of Chief Tecopa Cemetery is \$450.00. The Town of Pahrump will handle collections of fees. This amount will be reimbursed to the family by the VA, after the family files the appropriate VA forms. (VA Form 40-1330)
5. The minimum deposit to reserve a niche in the columbarium at the Veterans Section of the Chief Tecopa cemetery will be the amount to cover the administrative fee of \$112.50.
6. The administrative fee is an amount equal to 25% of the total niche cost. This (nonrefundable) fee is forfeited when relinquishing an assigned niche thus cancelling a Niche Agreement.
7. Only approved niche covers with engraving provided by the Department of Veterans Affairs will be allowed on the columbarium in the Veterans Section of the Chief Tecopa Cemetery. To obtain an engraved niche cover for qualified Veteran VA form 40-1330 must be completed and sent to the Department Of Veterans Affairs. The niche covers at the Veterans Section of chief Tecopa Cemetery (Columbarium) are to be uniform with the State and Federal Cemeteries.

8. Currently there is no cost for niche covers for qualified Veterans, if a completed VA Form 40-1330 is submitted to the Department of Veterans Affairs and approved by them. For qualifying spouses of a Veteran, the Veteran should contact an approved VA contractor for the niche cover. In this instance the niche cover engraving costs must be covered at the requestor's own expense.
