1. Call to Order, Moment of Silence, and Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Kulkin called the meeting to order.

Dr. Waters led the Moment of Silence and Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Consideration to Move the Order of or Deleting an Agenda Item(s).

Dr. Waters moved item 16 to 7a and item 15 to 7b.

3. Public Comment: Action may not be taken upon matters considered during this item until specifically included on an agenda for action. – NRS241.020(2)(c)(3).

Public comment was heard.

Mrs. Riches thanked everyone for their comments.

Mr. Adams stated he was against the vote of the county and had been for waste water being used at the fairgrounds. He also stated that he felt board and public should remember why the use of public comment is used and to be quick in statements.

Dr. Waters reminded everyone that the board was working until January 2015.

Mr. Dolan stated that once a letter had been drafted to the county on their intent it would be helpful to clarify what will be happening.

Mr. Kulkin stated he would like to see the Town Board reinstated.

Ms. Holecheck stated that she wanted to make a point of that fact that the sales tax was voted down which did not give the fire department anything extra to help the people of Pahrump.

5. Announcements

Announcements were read by Dr. Waters.

Mr. Adams announced that Resource Advisory Board appointments have been made.

6. Consideration to adopt Consent agenda items:

- a. Action – Approval of Town Vouchers.
- b. Action – Approval of Town Board meeting minutes for May 13, 2014.
- c. Action- Approval of the Town Board Final Budget Minutes from May 15, 2014.

Dr. Waters pulled item 6d for discussion.

Dolan approved consent agenda items 6a, 6b, 6c, 6e.

Riches seconded.

Motion carried 5-0.

Dr. Waters questioned what was being approved such as a resolution.

Mr. Adams said that it was to recognize safety week. It was decided to re-agendize with a Proclamation for the next meeting.

7. Advisory Board Reports from Advisory Board Chairpersons and/or Town Board Liaisons on the Status of Advisory Boards.

Mr. Pawlak stated that he asked people to apply for the NWEAB.

8. Consideration to approve and issue RFP for the installation of the Kellogg Park waterline.

This item was heard after item 12.

Ms. Holecheck stated that it should cost about \$135,000.

Mr. Dolan motioned to approve and issue RFP for the installation of Kellogg Park waterline.

Mrs. Riches seconded.

Motioned carried, 5-0.

9. Consideration approval of contract with KPVM-TV, Inc for obtaining sponsorships for the 2014 Pahrump Fall Festival.

Ms. Holecheck stated that this was the best proposal of the two and KPVM was selected because of the audio, visual and print options.

Mr. Dolan motioned to approve the contract with KPVM-TV, Inc for obtaining sponsorships for the 2014 Pahrump Fall Festival.
Mrs. Riches seconded.
Motion carried, 5-0.

10. Consideration and discussion of approving participation in Communities of Distinction television segment.

Ms. Holecheck stated the producers of the show want to show Pahrump in a favorable light. It will cost \$24,000 because it will air on the Discovery Channel and will be shown 30 more times for 5 minutes. If we paid the fee we could keep licensing rights and use in different forums.

Mrs. Riches asked what exactly is being filmed.

Ms. Holecheck stated that someone such as Tim Hafen would be interviewed since he has been here for a long time.

Mr. Dolan stated that using this film the people in the community could also use this film in their productions as well. He asked why this wouldn't be using Tourism money.

Ms. Holecheck stated that she sees the point and she is unsure if it is possible but she will check and get back to the board.

Mr. Adams stated that he was in favor of it but that he was unsure of the money coming from Pahrump Tourism Advisory Board.

Ms. Holecheck stated that if Pahrump was not selected then no money would be owed. Public comment was heard.

Mr. Dolan motioned to participation in the Communities of Distinction and asking Mr. Hafen to be our spokesman and not to exceed \$24,800 and to ask our lawyers about using Room tax money to pay the fee.

Dr. Waters seconded.

Motion carried, 4-1 with Mr. Adams voting nay.

11. Consideration to approve and accept quote from JM concrete LLC in the amount of \$15,400.00 and approve funding for Petrack Park Basketball court overlay.

Heard after item 9.

Mr. Dolan motioned to approve and accept quote from JM concrete LLC in the amount \$15,400.00 and approve funding for Petrack Park Basketball Court.

Mrs. Riches seconded.

Motion carried, 5-0.

12. Consideration to approve and accept contact and approve funding with Rocky Mountain Professional Rodeo Association for the 2014 Fall Festival Rodeo.

This item was moved forward to after item 8.

Ms. Holecheck stated this group was used for 3 years. She stated there is a line item that raised the prize money, because they believed it would bring more participation.

Mr. Dolan motioned to approve item 12 not to exceed \$27,000.

Mrs. Riches seconded.

Motion carried, 5-0.

13. Consideration to approve purchase of a 2014 Groundsmaster 3280-D 2WD Toro riding mower 72” Guardian Recycler deck.

Mr. Riches asked what park the new mower would be used at.

Mr. Luis stated that one of the mowers is a “money pit.” The 1999 is unusable and that the staff is working on them as best they can, but Ian Duetch Park has the most amount of grass as well as the thicker grass and will require the most work.

Mr. Dolan motioned to approve 2014 Groundsmaster 3280-D 2WD Toro riding mower 72” Guardian Recycler deck not to exceed \$21,000.

Mr. Adams seconded.

Motion carried, 5-0.

14. Consideration and discussion of acquisition for transitional Veterans and/or Senior Housing possibility.

Ms. Holecheck stated there is a location in Pahrump that would be good for transitional Veterans or Senior living but she did not want to go into much detail so no one steals the option.

The board agreed that this was a great investment and directed staff to continue working on this project with the county as well.

**15. Consideration to approve funding for a War Memorial Walk at the Chief Tecopa Cemetery.
*This item was heard after item 16.***

The Veterans Memorial Advisory Board gave a presentation on the War Memorial Veterans walk.

Mr. Dolan asked why they was shown 13 plaques instead of 12 and could the markers be 18 x 18 instead of 16 x 16.

The owner’s of the company explained 18” would be more costly.

Mr. Jones stated that they were working with the Puites on one for the Indians (Native Americans) so that’s why 13 were shown.

Public comments were heard.

Dr. Waters motioned to approve funding for a War Memorial Walk at the Chief Tecopa Cemetery not to exceed \$5,000.

Dolan seconded.

Motion carried, 5-0.






