Airport Lease N-85470 Environmental Analysis Determination

We received a lease application on July 28, 2008 from the Town of Pahrump for an airport encompassing 2,560 acres of public land located in the southwest area of Pahrump Valley.

After further review by both the Pahrump and Barstow Field Offices, a few concerns have arisen including the purpose and need of the airport, and potential impacts to the surrounding residential communities, wilderness areas, and Death Valley National Park. These potential impacts include, but are not limited to:

- Air Quality
- Biotic Communities Flora and Fauna
- Compatible Land Use
- Construction Impacts
- Endangered and Threatened Species of Flora and Fauna
- Energy Supply and Natural Resources
- Floodplains
- Impacts upon Public Recreation Areas and Historical/Cultural Resources
- Induced Socioeconomic Impacts
- Light Emissions
- Noise
- Social Impacts
- Solid Waste Impacts

- Traffic Impacts
- Visual resources
- Water Quality
- Wild and Scenic Rivers

According to 40 CFR 1502.4, Major Federal actions requiring the preparation of Environmental Impact Statements (EIS) is required. Given these concerns, the Bureau of Land Management Pahrump Field Office recommends that a comprehensive NEPA analysis is needed. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is required for this application.
