

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-02
PAHRUMP TOWN BOARD

Supporting Nye County Commissioners in
Moving County Boundary Line South and East

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump has taken particular notice of the increased population growth in Clark County near the Nye County line; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump has been informed that major commercial businesses may soon reside in Clark County near the Nye County line; and

WHEREAS, Nye County and the Town of Pahrump are currently and, will in the future, provide services including fire, ambulance and police, to these residents in Clark County as necessary; and

WHEREAS, the current system of repaying Nye County and the Town of Pahrump for these services is totally inadequate; and

WHEREAS, Nye County has entered into discussions with Clark County regarding moving the county line east and south so as to place these new residents in Nye County; and

WHEREAS, the moving of the county boundary line would generate tax revenues that would assist Nye County and the Town of Pahrump in the providing of these services, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the incorporated Town of Pahrump is responsible for the health, welfare and safety of all residents in its service areas.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump does hereby resolve as follows:




