WHEREAS, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump has taken notice of protests by the Bureau of Land Management and the U.S. Department of Fish & Game made against the transfer of water rights in and around the Amargosa Valley; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump considers these protests to be intrusive and frivolous; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump would like to express its support for the residents of the Amargosa Valley wanting to lawfully transfer their water rights; and




NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump does hereby resolve as follows:


1. That the Town Board of the Town of Pahrump hereby supports the residents of Amargosa Valley in their lawful pursuit of transferring their water rights.




