PAHRUMP TOWN BOARD

Supporting the variance filed by Nye County with the State Board of Health to be allowed to contract with a private firm to conduct inspections for building permits, sewage disposal systems and other related matters.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump has taken particular notice of actions affecting the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of Pahrump; and

WHEREAS, the Nye County Board of Commissioners is attempting to contract with a private firm to conduct inspections for building permits, sewage disposal systems and other related services; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada State Board of Health has stated that the County shall need a variance from state law in order to contract with said private firm; and

WHEREAS, the Nye County Board of Commissioners are in the process of submitting said variance; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump to support the County of Nye in this variance and in the contracting of private inspection services.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump does hereby resolve as follows:
