*Resolution Supporting the Certificate of Need for  
a Hospital to be Built in Pahrump, Nevada*

*WHEREAS, THE Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump is charged with the responsibility of providing for the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump; and*

*WHEREAS, the Town of Pahrump is in need of hospital services to which the community has not been provided; and*

*WHEREAS, the Pahrump Town Board desires to have these services for the citizens of Pahrump Valley; and*

*WHEREAS, Johnson Controls, Inc. and Banner Health Service have both submitted requests for a "Certificate of Need" to build a hospital in Pahrump, Nevada.*

*NOW, THEREFORE, the Town board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump does hereby resolve as follows::*

- 1. The Pahrump Town Board urges the State Department of Human Resources, Division of Health, to act expeditiously by providing the "Certificate of Need" and awarding it to the best qualified company according to its standards.*
- 2. That the Pahrump Town Board supports whichever company that will be awarded the "Certificate of Need" by the State of Nevada.*

*The Board further recommends the State approve the "Certificate of Need" to the company it finds most worthy and viable.*
