

RESOLUTION NO. 2001- 08
PAHRUMP TOWN BOARD

Resolution accepting annexation of property / properties obtained through extension of Nye County Boundaries, and the Town of Pahrump, Nevada boundaries pursuant to Nye County Bill 2001-09 and State of Nevada Legislative Session 2001, Senate Bill 395

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump is charged with the responsibility of providing for the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump; and

WHEREAS, the boundaries of Nye County and the unincorporated Town of Pahrump, Nevada have been extended pursuant to Nevada State Senate Bill 395 and Nye County Bill Number 2001-09; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the incorporated Town of Pahrump has taken particular notice of negotiations of the Nevada State Legislature regarding the granting of a boundary line change between Nye County, Nevada and Clark County, Nevada to alter the current boundary line between the respective counties; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump, Nevada has accepted the provisions of Senate Bill 395 of the 2001 Nevada Legislature and Nye County Bill Number 2001-09; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Nye County Commissioners having agreed to the boundary line changes pursuant to SB 395 of the 2001 Nevada Legislature and Nye County Bill Number 2001-09; and

WHEREAS, certain properties previously situated in Clark County are included in the Nye County Boundary line changes and it is the intent of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump to accept these properties into the boundaries of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump, Nevada; and

WHEREAS, the unincorporated Town of Pahrump has previously indicated that there should be a revision in the maps of the area commonly known as Calvada Valley Unit #14; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump has previously agreed to the revision of said maps while reiterating that Calvada Valley Unit #14 has always existed within the sovereign boundaries of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump, the revision of this map notwithstanding; and

WHEREAS, Nevada Revised Statutes requires acceptance of the annexed properties by the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump, or the Board of Nye County Commissioners; and
