

RESOLUTION NO. 2001-09

Expressly indicating to the Nye County Board of Commissioners the Town Board's desire to leave the Town boundary in the area north of Roadrunner Road as is and without change and further expressly objecting to any consideration by the Nye County Commission to alter the Town boundary in the area north of Roadrunner Road.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump has taken particular notice of actions affecting the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of Pahrump; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump is aware that the Nye County Commission is considering adjusting the Town boundary specifically in the area north of Roadrunner Road; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump opposes any adjustment in that specific area which would remove property from the unincorporated Town of Pahrump; and




NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump does hereby resolve as follows;
