

RESOLUTION NO. 2001-10
PAHRUMP TOWN BOARD

Supporting the residents of Klamath, Oregon in their lawful pursuit in having the Bureau of Reclamation return their water rights.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump has taken particular notice of actions affecting the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of Pahrump; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump has taken notice of the actions taken by the Bureau of Reclamation by reallocating water resources for wildlife; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump considers these action by the bureau of Reclamation to be intrusive; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump would like to express its support for the residents of Klamath, Oregon wanting to lawfully regain their water rights; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump would like to express that the Endangered Species Act should be amended to also protect human life,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump does hereby resolve as follows;

1. That the Town Board of the Town of Pahrump hereby supports the residents of Klamath, Oregon in their lawful pursuit in having the Bureau of Reclamation return their water rights given to them by the 1902 Reclamation Act by former President Teddy Roosevelt.
2. That the Town Board of the Town of Pahrump hereby supports having the Federal Government amend the Endangered Species Act to include human life.
