

Resolution 2002-01
PAHRUMP TOWN BOARD

A Resolution Stating that the Pahrump Valley Fire-Rescue Service be the Main Ambulance Provider and No Such Private Ambulance Service will be Allowed to Operate within the Pahrump Valley without the Explicit Permission of the Pahrump Town Board, and then Only if in Compliance with an Ordinance Pertaining to Ambulance Service.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump owns and operates the Pahrump Valley Fire-Rescue Service, which provides fire, and ambulance, and transfer service to the residents of the Pahrump Valley; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump wishes to retain the right to approve or deny any requests from a private ambulance service who wishes to operate in the Pahrump Valley, or to retain such right as to be the sole ambulance provider for the Pahrump Valley; and


WHEREAS, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump will at all times consider what is in the best interest of the citizens of the Pahrump Valley.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump does hereby resolve as follows:

The Town Board and the Officers of the Pahrump Valley Fire-Rescue Service will create an ordinance pertaining to the health and welfare of the citizens of the valley for a municipal ambulance service and the possible inclusion or exclusion of private ambulance service(s) operating in the unincorporated Town of Pahrump.


