**A RESOLUTION URGING THE NYE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO  
CREATE A RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO NRS 405.010 SETTING LIMITS ON LOAD  
AND WEIGHT AND PROSCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF FOR  
MALIBOU STREET FROM GAMEBIRD TO DANDELION STREETS**

WHEREAS, residents of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump residing on Malibou Street, between Gamebird and Dandelion Streets, have asked the Town Board for relief from heavy truck traffic routinely utilizing Malibou Street at that location, believing that truck traffic presents a threat to life and property; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Pahrump has found that routine heavy truck traffic on Malibou Street between Gamebird and Dandelion Streets poses a threat to the Health, Safety, and Welfare of the residents of Malibou Street; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Pahrump is not authorized to take action independent of the Nye County Board of Commissioners who have the responsibility for streets and roads in the unincorporated Town of Pahrump; now

THEREFORE, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump does hereby resolve as follows:

The Nye County Board of Commissioners is strongly urged to consider approving a resolution setting limits on load and weight and proscribing penalties for violation thereof for Malibou Street from Gamebird to Dandelion Streets. In drafting this resolution, the Town Board asks Nye County to make exceptions for: (1) mail or package pickup and delivery vehicles; (2) school busses; (3) trash removal vehicles; (4) building materials and/or construction; (5) trucks carrying supplies to be delivered in the immediate neighborhood; and (6) fire and emergency vehicles.
