**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION OF NYE COUNTY FOR  
PUBLIC LANDS FOR COMMUNITY PURPOSES AND ECONOMIC  
DEVELOPMENT FOR THE TOWN OF PAHRUMP.**

WHEREAS, the Town of Pahrump is supporting the Nye County Board of Commissioners in coordinating with its Federal delegations to prepare legislation that addresses public land issues the County may face during the next 10 to 15 years and designates land for future community purposes and economic development; and

WHEREAS, the Town is requesting the County include for direct disposal the estimated 3,400 acres shown on the attached map (Exhibit 1) that is proposed for community purposes, and economic development; and

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:** The Pahrump Town Board recommends the Nye County Board of Commissioners include these public lands in their coordination with the Federal delegations designating land for future community purposes and economic development and authorizes the Town Manager to sign any documents required to support this request.




