**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING GOVERNOR GUINN SUPPORT PLACEMENT
OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AT KEY INTERSECTIONS IN THE TOWN**

WHEREAS, the vehicle traffic volume is increasing on the Town's streets and at key intersections with State highways including but not limited to Blagg Road and SR 372, and Homestead Road and SR 160; and

WHEREAS, the number of deadly vehicle accidents at those key intersections is increasing along with the traffic volumes; and

WHEREAS, the State of Nevada Department of Transportation has resisted placement of traffic control devices at those key intersections; and

WHEREAS, Pahrump Valley High School students have requested Town Board support in encouraging Governor Guinn to take action in this regard; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: the Town Board of Pahrump supports the efforts of the Pahrump Valley High Scholl students in the placement of traffic control devices at key intersections and encourages Governor Guinn to take action in this regard at the earliest possible date.


