

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-17
TOWN OF PAHRUMP, NEVADA

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING APPROVAL OF COLA INCREASES OF 4.2%
FOR NON-BARGAINING UNIT EMPLOYEES, AND DISCRETIONARY MERIT
INCREASES NOT TO EXCEED 4%**

WHEREAS, the Town's Personnel Policy Manual allows for annual COLA and merit increases; and

WHEREAS, the Consumer Price Index for all urban consumers for the past 12 months through May of 2006 is +4.2% and there is a budget appropriation to cover that expense;

WHEREAS, the budget appropriation for merit increases is 4% for which the Administration would like discretionary authority to approve; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: the Town Board of Pahrump approves a 4.2% COLA wage increases for non-bargaining unit employees effective July 1, 2006, and authorizes the Town Manager to approve merit increases not to exceed 4%, both of which are budgeted.
