A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING PAHRUMP ALLIANCE FOR VALLEY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT (PAVED) AS THE TOWN'S OFFICIAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZATION IN MATTERS RELATED TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT OF THE PAHRUMP ARTS AND RECREATION COMPLEX (PARC).

WHEREAS, the Town of Pahrump is favored with numerous economic development opportunities such as local businesses desiring to expand, or other businesses willing to explore the potential of relocating to Pahrump; and

WHEREAS, the development of the Pahrump Arts and Recreation Complex (PARC) is a tremendous opportunity and major undertaking requiring the focused attention of an organization devoted to its success in addition to the other economic development opportunities that are present; and

WHEREAS, the proposed non-profit corporation Pahrump Valley Alliance for Economic Development (PAVED) is willing and able to undertake the aforementioned economic development projects with the assistance of a nine (9) member Board of Directors comprised of Alfred Balloqui, the Town Board Chairperson, the Town Manager, and six (6) other selected members of the community; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: the Town Board of Pahrump recognizes Pahrump Alliance for Valley Economic Development (PAVED) as the Town's official economic development organization in matters related to economic development including but not limited to the planning and development of the Pahrump Arts and Recreation Complex (PARC).




