PAHRUMP TOWN BOARD

A RESOLUTION URGING THE NYE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO APPROVE AN APPLICATION TO THE BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT TO LEASE AND PURCHASE LAND FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF "LAST CHANCE PARK".

WHEREAS, the unincorporated Town of Pahrump has identified the need for additional public recreational opportunities; and

WHEREAS, additional public recreation opportunities in the form of trails for biking, equestrian activities, and all terrain vehicles can be provided at the "Last Chance Park" comprising 1405 acres, the legal description of which is contained in the enclosed application (Form 2740) to the Bureau of Land Management (BLM); and

WHEREAS, the subject property is currently managed by the BLM and the unincorporated Town of Pahrump is authorized to take action independent of the Nye County Board of Commissioners in regard to the proposed application for lease and purchase of the property; now

THEREFORE, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump does hereby resolve as follows:

The Nye County Board of Commissioners is strongly urged to seek concurrence of the proposed application to lease and purchase property described in the attached application for the development on the "Last Chance Park".
