RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Pahrump Town Board of the Unincorporated Town of Pahrump on April 26, 1988 adopted a Room Tax Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, an Advisory Committee has been appointed to make recommendations on how these funds should be expended to the Pahrump Town Board;

NOW THEREFORE, the Pahrump Town Board does hereby adopt the following guide lines for the expending of these funds:

1. Organizations who are already receiving funds from Room Tax are not eligible to file for additional grants from the Room Tax Fund.
2. Applicants project must be tourism oriented.
3. Applications must be received by the committee 10 days before the quarterly meeting.
4. All applicants are required to file a report on how the grant was used within 30 days following the event.
5. Applicants are eligible for one grant per year.
6. Applications will be received for events that will occur in the next quarter of the year.
