RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH AN INVESTMENT POLICY FOR TOWN FUNDS ON DEPOSIT WITH THE NYE COUNTY TREASURER

Whereas, at a regular meeting of the Town Board of Pahrump Town, County of Nye, State of Nevada, held on March 8, 1990, 1990, the following resolution was adopted:

Whereas, the Town Board has determined that a need exists to establish an investment policy for funds of the town on deposit with the Nye County Treasurer.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Town Board's policy for the investment of funds is as follows:

1. All investments will be those authorized by the laws of Nevada.
2. No investment will have a maturity beyond six (6) months of date of purchase.
3. All investments will be done by written communication to the Nye County Treasurer from the Town Manager or Town Clerk and will be reported on at the next regular Board meeting.
4. The Board recognizes that situations may arise in which the Nye County Treasurer may find that a prompt decision may need to be made. When this occurs, either the Town Manager or Town Clerk may communicate a decision to the Nye County Treasurer by telephone. A written communication confirming the decision is then to be made.
5. The interest earned is to be credited to the fund from which the investments are made.







PAHRUMP TOWN BOARD RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Pahrump recognizes the growth of residences and businesses within the unincorporated Town of Pahrump, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Pahrump recognizes that some of these new businesses may include adult oriented businesses and,

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Pahrump recognizes that privileged adult oriented businesses, namely: prostitution, escort services and massage parlors are specifically regulated by the County of Nye, by and through its grant of authority, N.R.S. 244.345, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Pahrump has no authority by virtue of said law to license, regulate or suppress these businesses on its own, and

WHEREAS, the County of Nye has previously exercised its authority over these privileged adult oriented businesses by virtue of Pahrump Ordinance No. 3, which prohibits prostitution in the unincorporated Town of Pahrump, and

WHEREAS, the County of Nye has passed a comprehensive licensing ordinance and regulates and suppresses adult oriented businesses by and through the Nye County Liquor and Brothel Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Pahrump resolves as follows:

1. That the County of Nye, by and through its Liquor and Brothel Board expand its jurisdiction over privileged adult

oriented businesses to include massage parlors and escort services as is their obligation under N.R.S. 244.345, and

2. That all privileged adult oriented businesses under the jurisdiction of the Nye County Liquor and Brothel Board be prohibited from licensure within the unincorporated Town of Pahrump in accordance with the intent expressed in Pahrump Ordinance No. 3.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Pahrump is experiencing a rapid rate of growth in both population and businesses, and

WHEREAS, it is to the best interests of the citizens of the Town of Pahrump for the growth to be controlled in an orderly and intelligent manner, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Pahrump is prohibited by Nevada Revised Statutes with the adoption of laws regarding zoning and planning, and

WHEREAS, in the past Nye County, on behalf of the Town of Pahrump, has requested and received various master plans and covenants, conditions and restrictions relative to the orderly and intelligent growth of the Town of Pahrump, and

WHEREAS, in the past Nye County has neglected to enforce certain provisions of these master plans and covenants, conditions and restrictions, and

WHEREAS, it is the obligation of Nye County to enforce the master plans and covenants, conditions and restrictions in order to fulfill its duties under the law and to fulfill its obligations regarding the Town of Pahrump.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Pahrump resolves as follows:

That the Board of County Commissioners for the County of Nye perform its duties and obligations as necessary in the strict enforcement of all master plans and covenants, conditions and restrictions regarding the Town of Pahrump.
