

AMENDED PAHRUMP TOWN BOARD RESOLUTION

TO: NYE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

DATE: FEBRUARY 23, 1993

SUBJECT: URGENT HEALTH CARE SERVICES FOR PAHRUMP CITIZENS

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Pahrump has examined a proposal by Cambridge Health System, Inc., a Nevada not-for-profit corporation, a/k/a Spring Valley Hospital, to provide medical out-reach services in Pahrump in coordination with the construction of a new hospital in Clark County, Nevada, and

WHEREAS, said proposal includes, among other plans, provisions for 24-hour emergency care, observation beds, chemotherapy and dialysis treatment and a pharmacy, staffed 24 hours a day by physicians and registered nurses, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has determined that these services are critically needed by the residents of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump and are in the best interests of the health and welfare of the residents of Pahrump, and

WHEREAS, as a condition of providing the above services, it is necessary for Cambridge Health System, Inc. to have authorized by the State of Nevada bonds which will be sold to finance the project, and

WHEREAS, the residents of the Town of Pahrump shall not be obligated, in any manner, relating to the sale of said bonds, and

WHEREAS, as a further condition to providing said services, Cambridge Health System, Inc. intends to petition the County Commissioners of Nye County, Nevada, to provide the physical hospital facility to be located within the unincorporated Town of Pahrump and which facility is to be paid for by Nye County, Nevada, and

WHEREAS, Cambridge Health System, Inc. has requested that the Town Board of the Town of Pahrump and Nye County, by and through the County Commissioners endorse its medical out-reach program to the State of Nevada in order to facilitate the authorization of said bonds, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has unanimously agreed that such a plan and proposal will inure to the best health and welfare of the citizens it represents.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump resolves as follows:

That the Town Board of the Town of Pahrump endorses and approves the plans for Cambridge Health System, Inc. to provide medical services to the unincorporated Town of Pahrump and urges both the County Commission of the County of Nye and the State of Nevada to support said plan as well as the authorization of bonds and the construction of the facility which will make these plans a reality.

Further, the Town Board of the Town of Pahrump resolves to assist and accept, in a manner to be determined by the Pahrump Town Board, in the financial responsibility attendant to this project.


Upon Motion duly made, seconded and carried, it is unanimously,

RESOLVED AND PROCLAIMED that Leonard and Becky Smith shall be designated HONORARY RESIDENTS of the Town of Fahrump.







CREATE SEPARATE FUND
PAHRUMP PORTION OF 5/8 CENTS OF 1 PERCENT
ROOM TAX

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that NAOMA LYDON, Nye County Auditor, is hereby authorized and directed by the Pahrump Town Board to create a separate fund for that portion of the State Room Tax Rate of Five Eights Percent (5/8%) of One Percent (1%) that is apportioned to the Town of Pahrump, and


WHEREAS, the separate fund is created as directed in the Interlocal Contract between the Nye County Commissioners and the Pahrump Town Board, dated June 15, 1993, and

WHEREAS, the purpose is to empower and obligate the Town of Pahrump to perform certain services and activities or undertakings as mandated by law to administer and use the retained room tax monies collected for the purpose of advertising the tourism related resources of and special events scheduled in the Town of Pahrump, and

FURTHERMORE, the Town of Pahrump requests a separate accounting of retained room tax to better perform the responsibilities and duties as administrator of these room tax monies, and the Fund will be designated, "STATE ROOM TAX FUND", Fund

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Nye County Auditor be directed by the Pahrump Town Board to create a separate fund for that room tax collected from the Five Eights Percent (5/8%) of One Percent (1%) that is apportioned to the Town of Pahrump.



RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FILING OF APPLICATION
PAHRUMP RECREATION AND SPORTS COMPLEX

WHEREAS, the Federal Land and Water Conservation Fund Act (P.L. 88-578) provides financial assistance to the State of Nevada for outdoor recreation purposes, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Pahrump desires financial assistance under the Land and Water Conservation Fund Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Pahrump Town Board as follows:

1. That the Pahrump Town Board hereby approved filing an application of Land and Water Conservation Fund financial assistance.

2. That Roger Baltz, Pahrump Town Manager, is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Nevada Division of State Parks.

3. That the Pahrump Town Board hereby does agree to finance 100 percent of the project cost, one-half of which will be reimbursed.

$$\frac{110,000}{\text{(Budgeted Funds \& Other Cash)}} + \frac{\quad}{\text{(Force Account)}} + \frac{20,000}{\text{(Donations)}} = \frac{130,000}{\text{(Total Project Cost)}}$$

4. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Pahrump Town Board does hereby appoint Roger Baltz, Pahrump Town Manager, as agent of the Pahrump Town Board to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including applications, agreements, billing statements, and so on which may be necessary for the completion of the above project.



TO: NYE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

DATE: NOVEMBER 23, 1993

SUBJECT: FIRST BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR THE PROPOSED
PAHRUMP COMMUNITY HOSPITAL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the growing population of the Town of Pahrump has made urgent medical care and an urgent medical care facility for the residents of Pahrump a priority item, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Pahrump is desirous of protecting the general health and welfare of the residents of the Town of Pahrump and is further charged with that responsibility, and

WHEREAS, the County of Nye is in the process of passing an Ordinance creating a hospital district for the use of the residents of the Town of Pahrump, and

WHEREAS, the first Board of Directors for said hospital district will be appointed by the Nye County Board of County Commissioners upon passage of said Ordinance, and

WHEREAS, this initial Board of Directors for the hospital district will be charged with the implementation, planning and budgeting of a permanent health care facility for the residents of the Town of Pahrump, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump believes these duties to be integrally tied to the welfare of the residents of the Town of Pahrump, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump feels that its advice and counsel can be beneficial to the selection of this first Board of Directors for the Pahrump Community Hospital District.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump resolves as follows:

That the Board of County Commissioners for the County of Nye allow the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump to participate in the selection of the first Board of Directors for the new Pahrump Community Hospital District, should said Ordinance creating the same be passed, and

Further, that the Board of County Commissioners for the County of Nye appoint one member of the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump to serve as a director on the initial Board of Directors for said hospital district.
